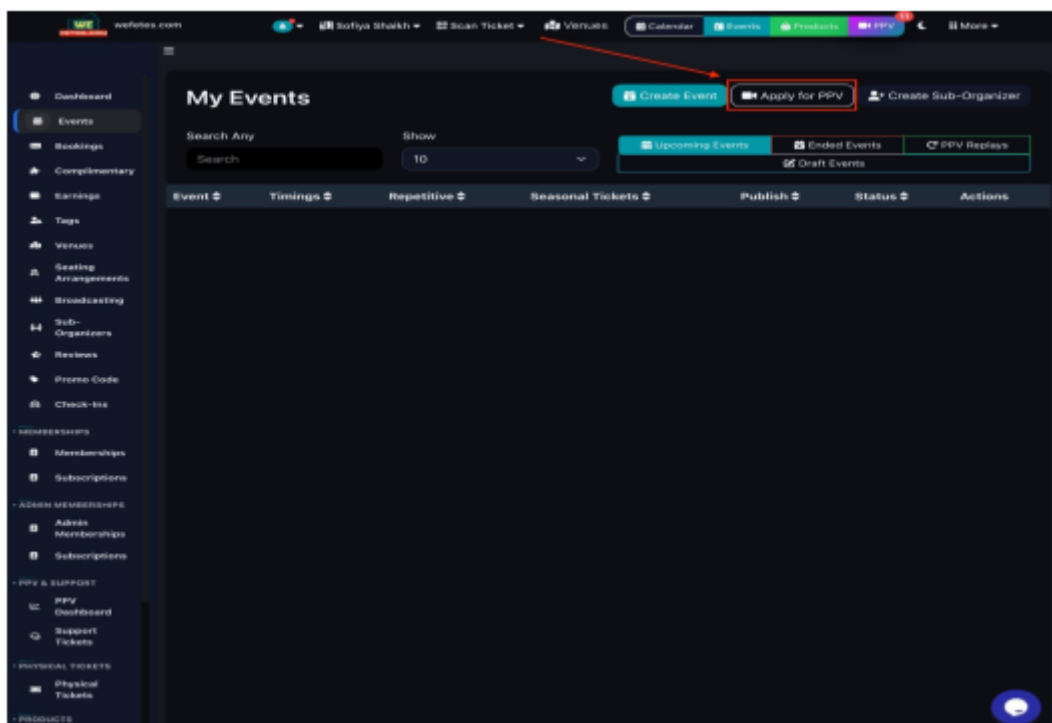

## For Organisers

### Apply for PPV

Before you can create PPV events, you must apply for PPV access. Once an admin approves your application, you can enable PPV on your events.

1. Log in as organiser and go to your Dashboard (e.g. My Events ).
2. Click the Apply for PPV button.
3. Fill in the application form (company, contact, streaming experience, content type, etc.).
4. Submit. An admin will review and approve or reject your application

## Admin: Approve or Reject PPV Applications

Organisers cannot create PPV events until an admin approves their PPV application.

When you Approve: The organiser can then create PPV events. When you Reject: The organiser cannot create PPV until they apply again and are approved

## PPV Event Types

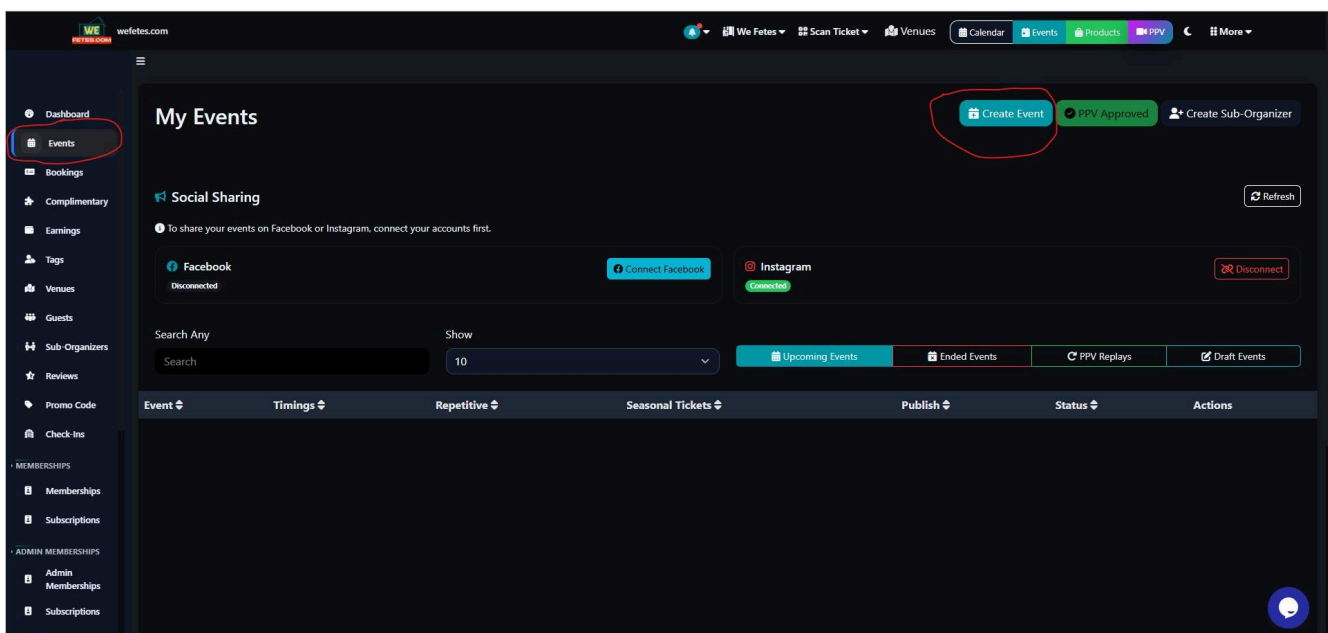
When you enable PPV on an event, you choose one of these stream types:

- **Create New Stream** — You want to go live; the system creates a stream and gives you an URL. Use that URL in your encoder to broadcast. No existing stream needed.
- **I Already Have a Stream URL** — You already have a live stream (e.g. from Flussonic or another provider). Paste your existing stream URL so customers can watch.
- **Replay Event** — Pre-recorded video only (no live). Enter a Replay URL (e.g. HLS .m3u8 or MP4). No stream server or encoder needed; the video is always available. You can record your PPV event directly from your Wefetes dashboard.

## Create a PPV Event (after approval)

After your PPV application is approved, you can create events that offer live or replay video. Enable PPV on the event and choose one of the PPV event types above (Create stream, Already have stream, or Replay).

1. Go to Dashboard → My Events. Click Create event or edit an existing event.

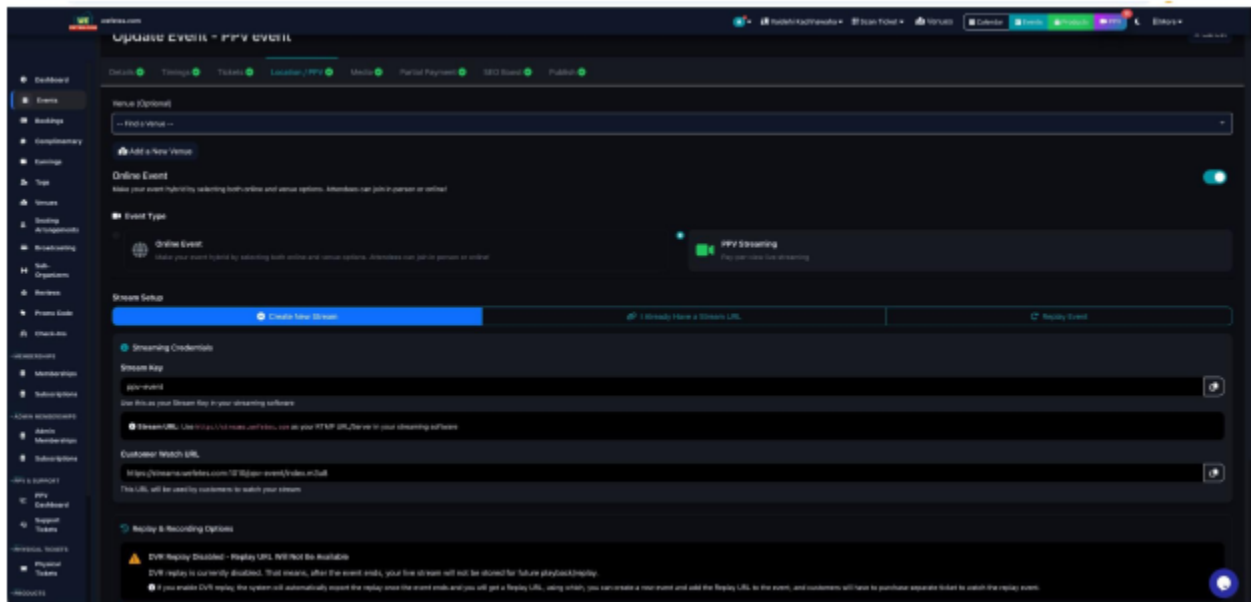

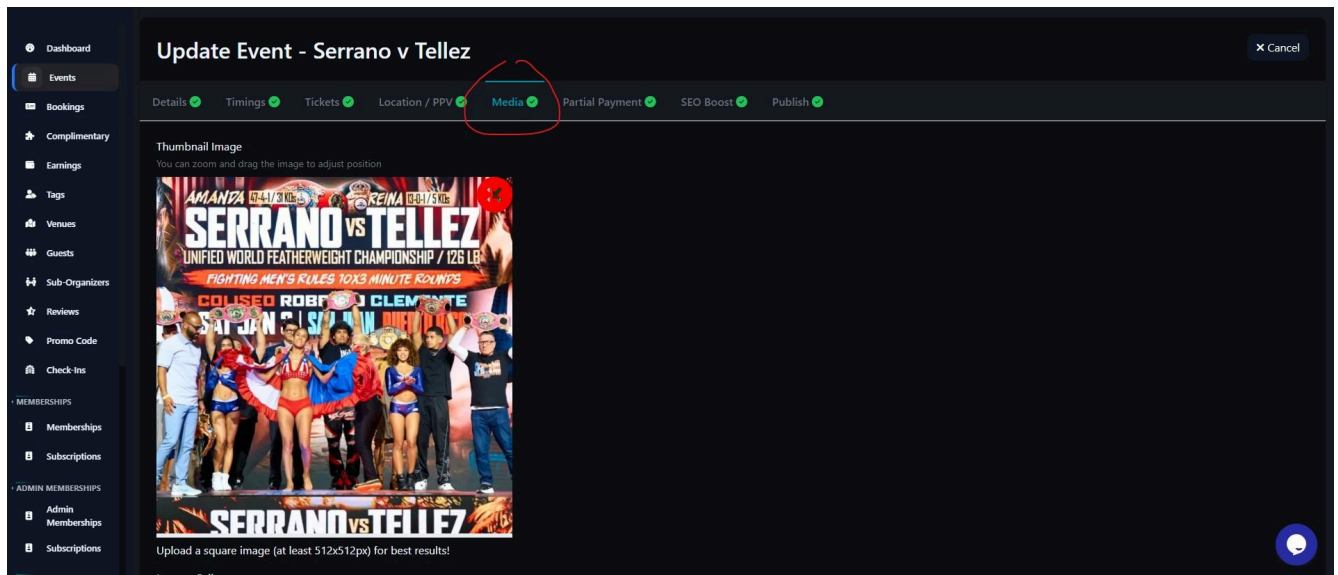

# Pay Per View Stream Format and Publishing

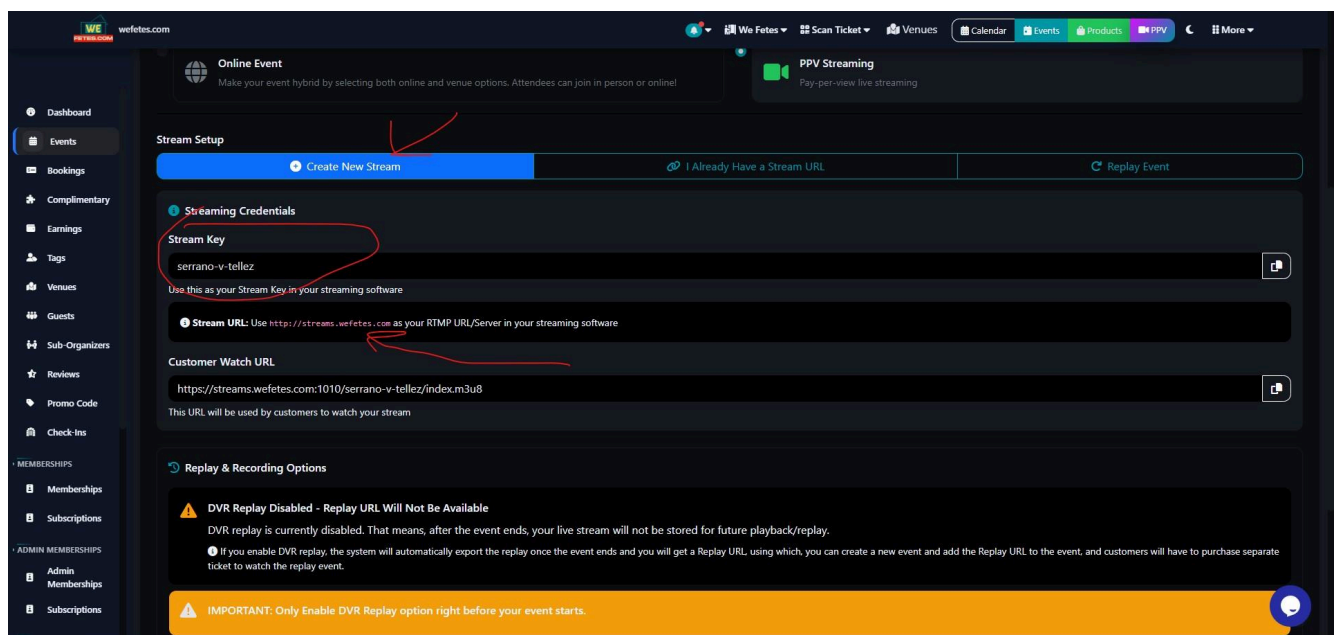
All streaming formats are distributed through the integrated streaming platform and cdn (content delivery network) for smooth customer playback.

## There three options for publishing Pay Per View events

- A. Creating a new stream using your streaming software
- B. Using Already created Stream Urls
- C. PPV Replay event

### A. Creating a new stream using your streaming software

1. The system will generate a stream key and provide you with a stream url.
2. Add this key and url streaming software



### B. Using Already created Stream Urls

1. If you already have a stream url from your Streaming Server you have use this to go live

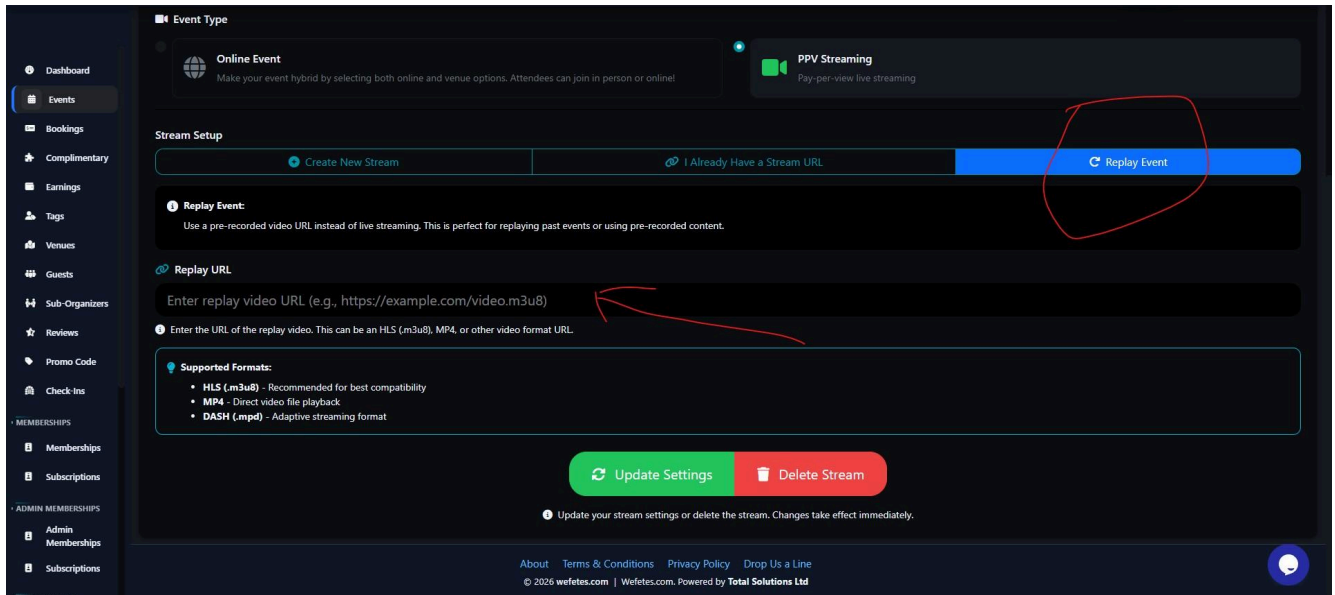

# PAY PER VIEW REPLAY/ DVR/ VOD

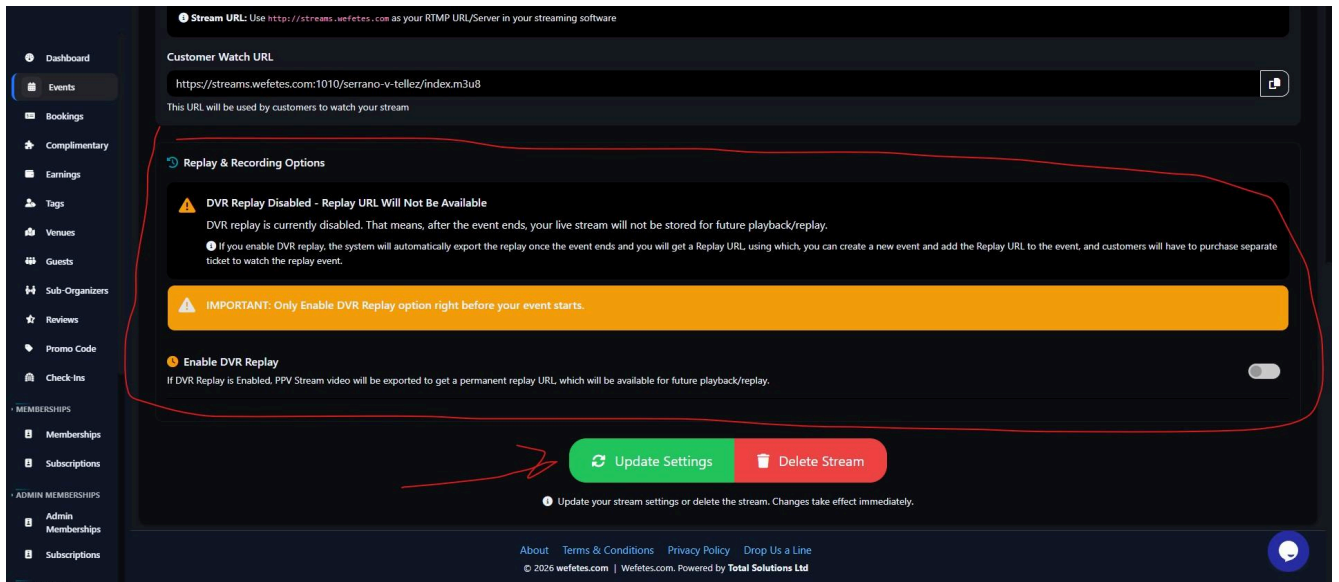
Using wefetes Replay feature is simple.

- a. Use you own recorded event url in mp4 format and add it as an replay event



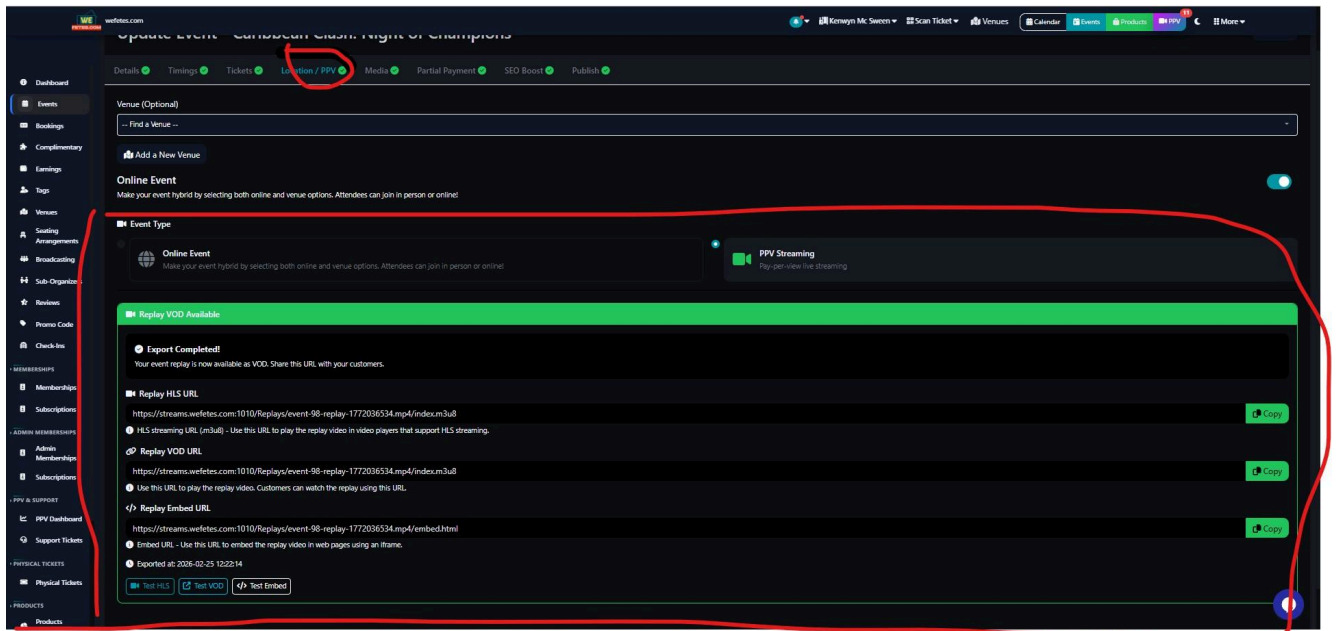
- b. Record your live ppv event through wefetes ppv system

1. At the start of your event enable dvr replay
2. Click Update



### 3. Event will start recording instantly

C. In order to view the Replay url PPV event must be marked as ended. Details lower in this article

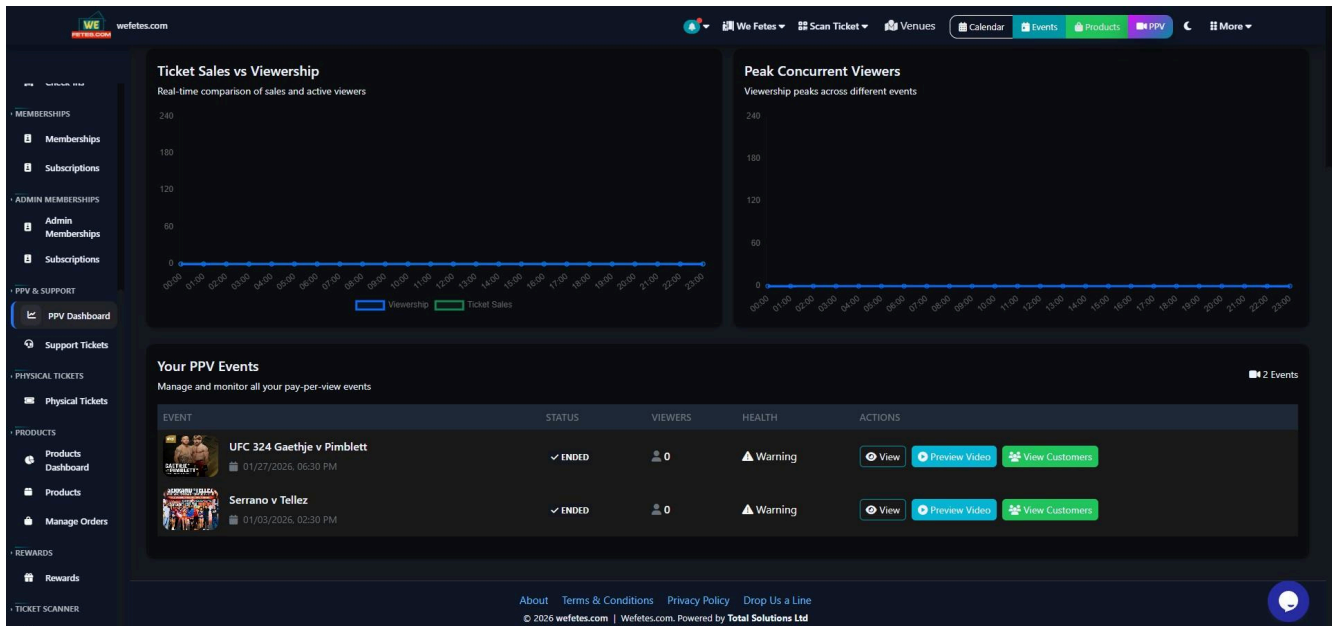
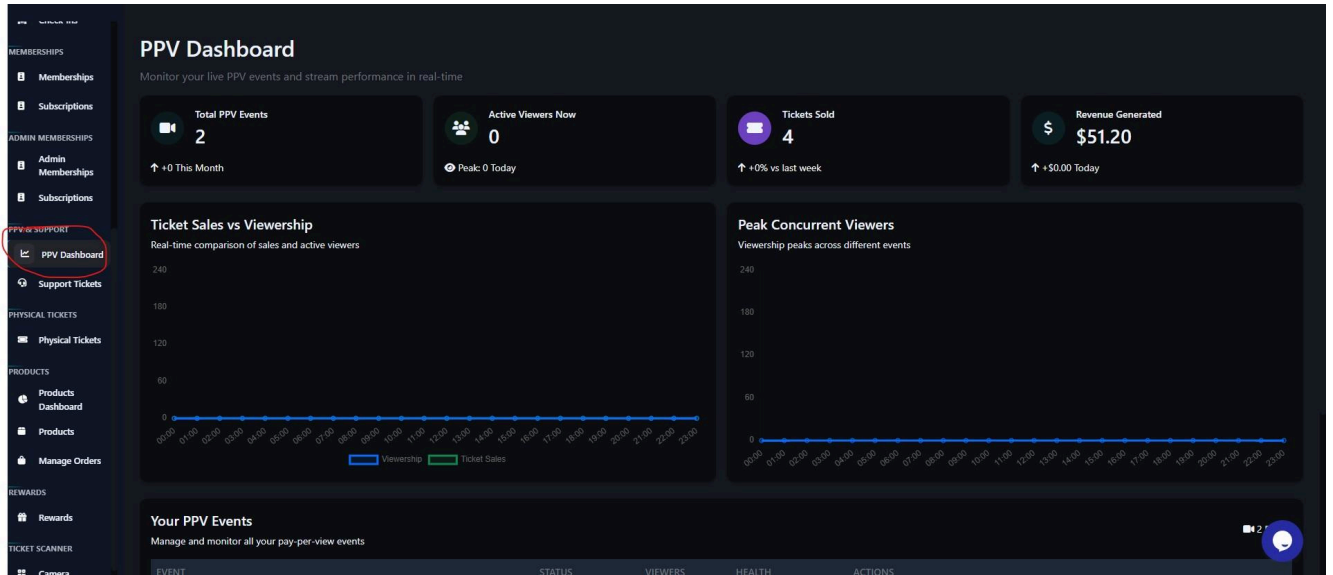


D. Create a completely new ppv Event select Repay Event and paste url that was generated from your end event.

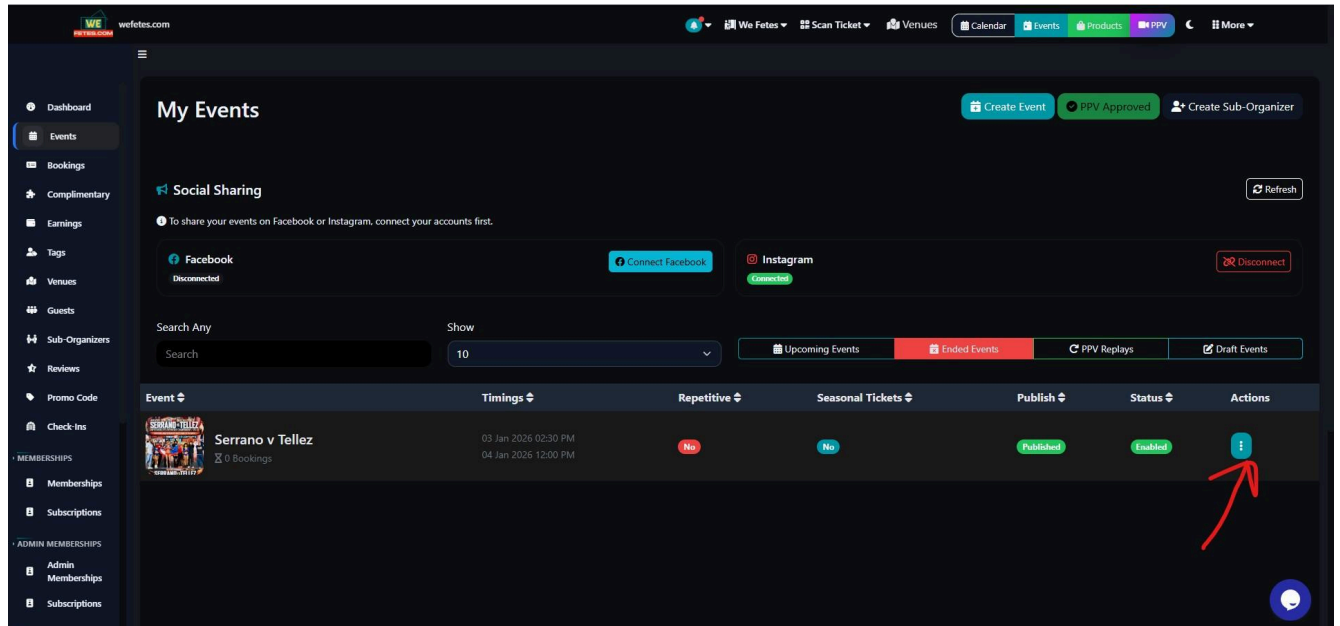

## End a Live PPV Event

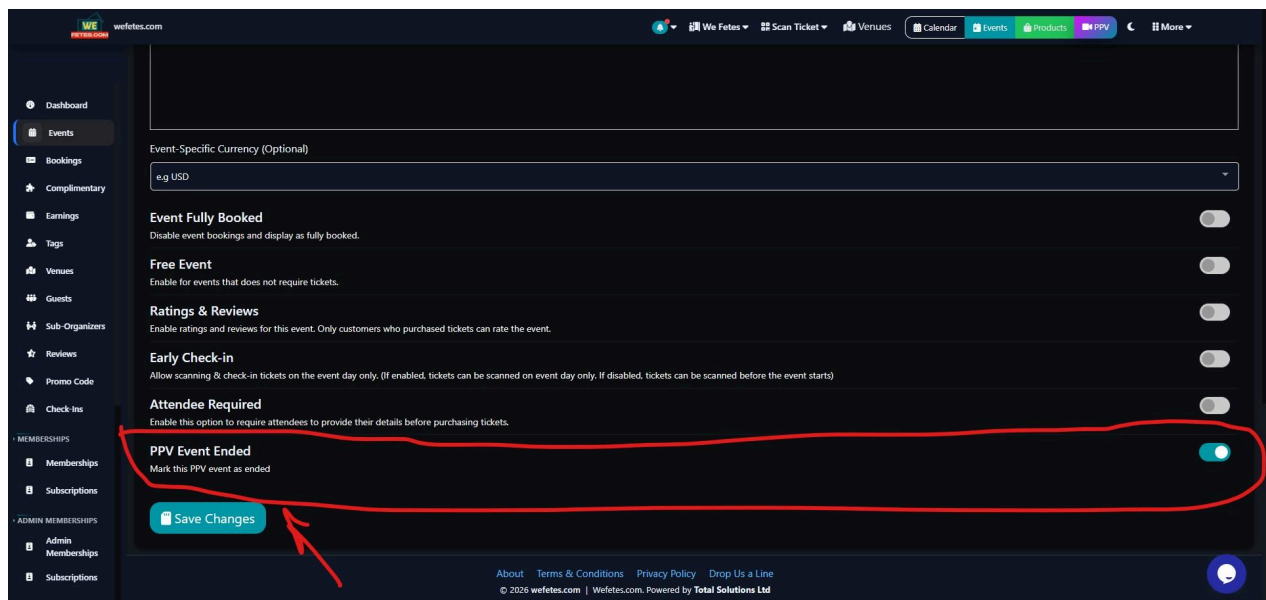
For live PPV events, when the broadcast is over you must mark the event as ended. If DVR is enabled, the system can then export the recording so customers can "Watch Again".

1. Go to Dashboard → My Events . Click the action button next to the ppv event and click Edit / Update Event.



2. Find the toggle PPV Event Ended on event page— *Mark this PPV event as ended.*

3. Turn the toggle on, then click Save Changes.



- If the Replay feature is being used this will automatically take you to the replay url for copying. (see replay section)

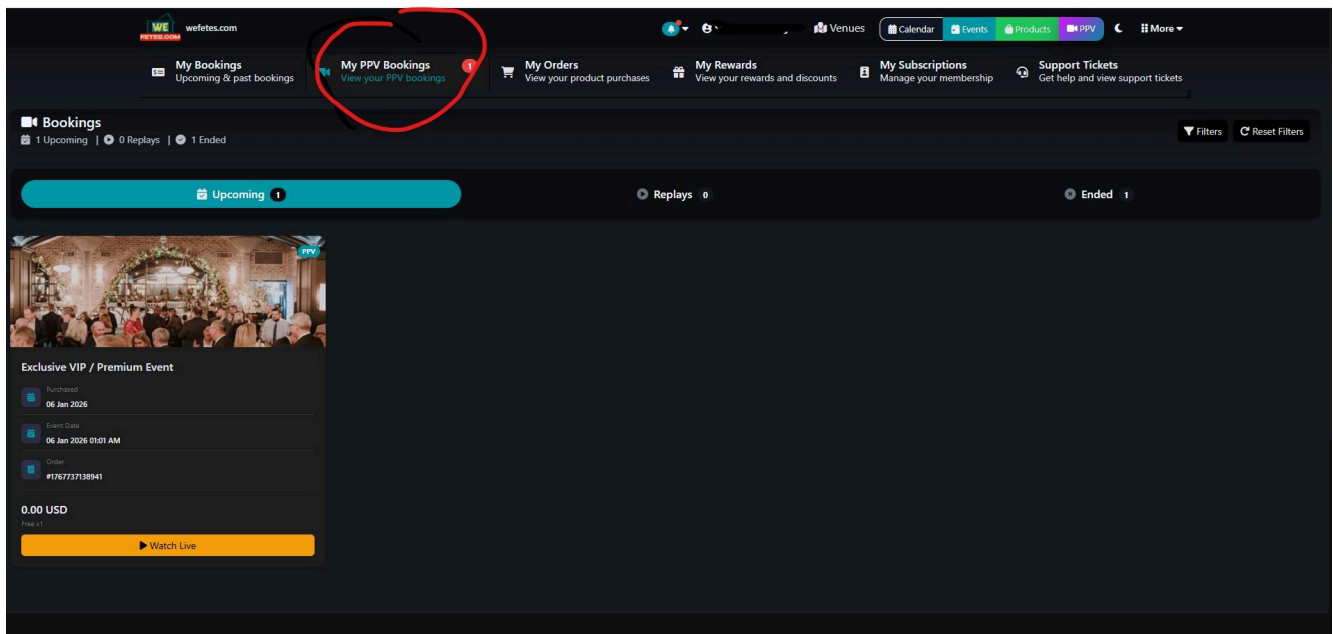
## Book a PPV Event

Customers book a PPV event like any other event: find the event, choose ticket and quantity, then checkout and pay. After payment the booking appears under My PPV Bookings.

1. Find the PPV event (event listing, search, or direct link).
2. Select ticket type and quantity (and date if multiple dates).
3. Click Book or Checkout and complete payment.

## My PPV Bookings (after booking)

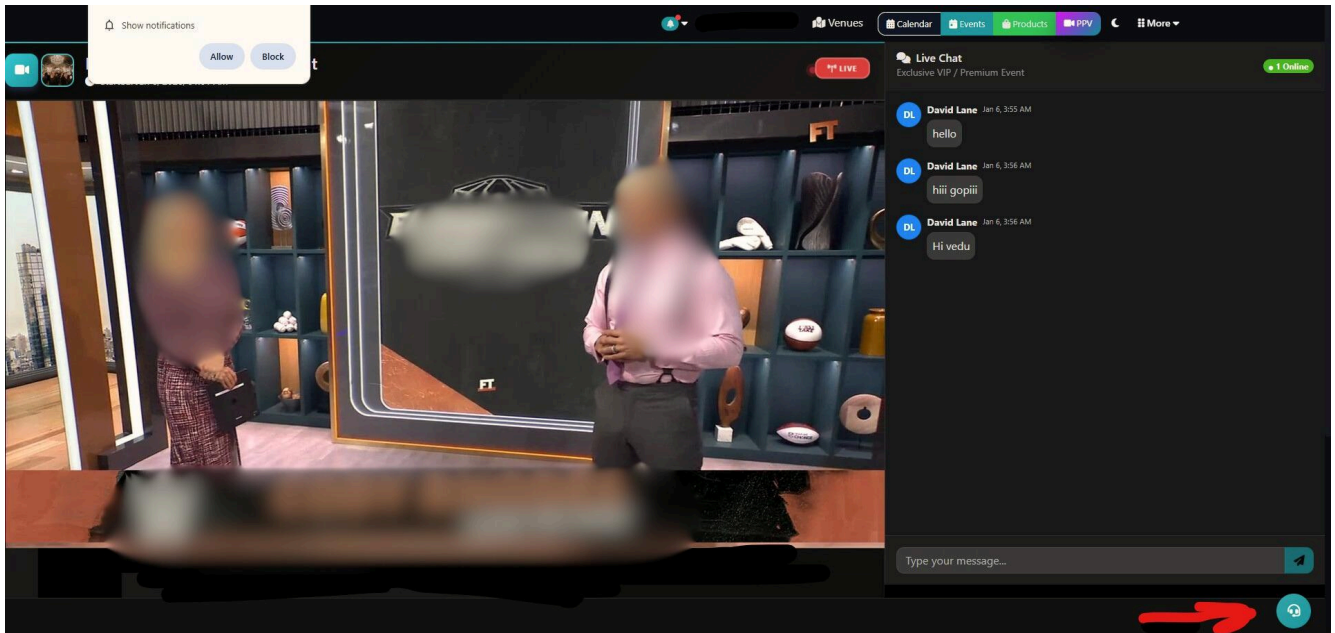
All your PPV purchases are listed under My PPV Bookings. You can filter by Valid / Live, Replays (Watch Again), and Expired.



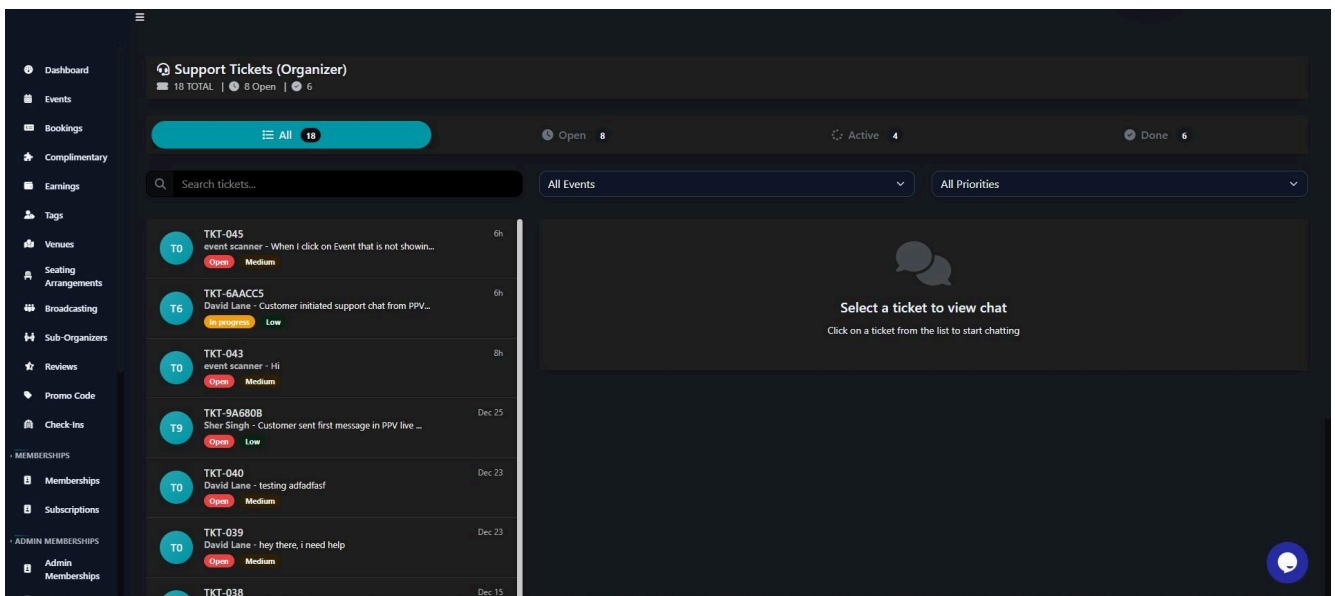
## Watch PPV Video

Customers can use live chat to hold a conversation and also click the support button to chat live with the organizer for any issues they may have. Open a ticket option is also available.

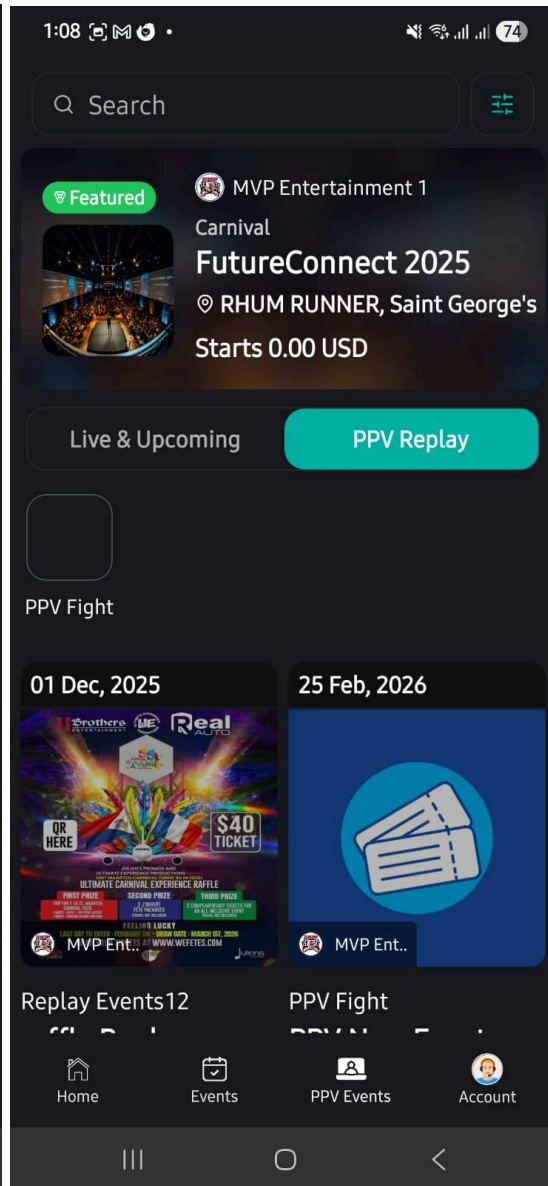
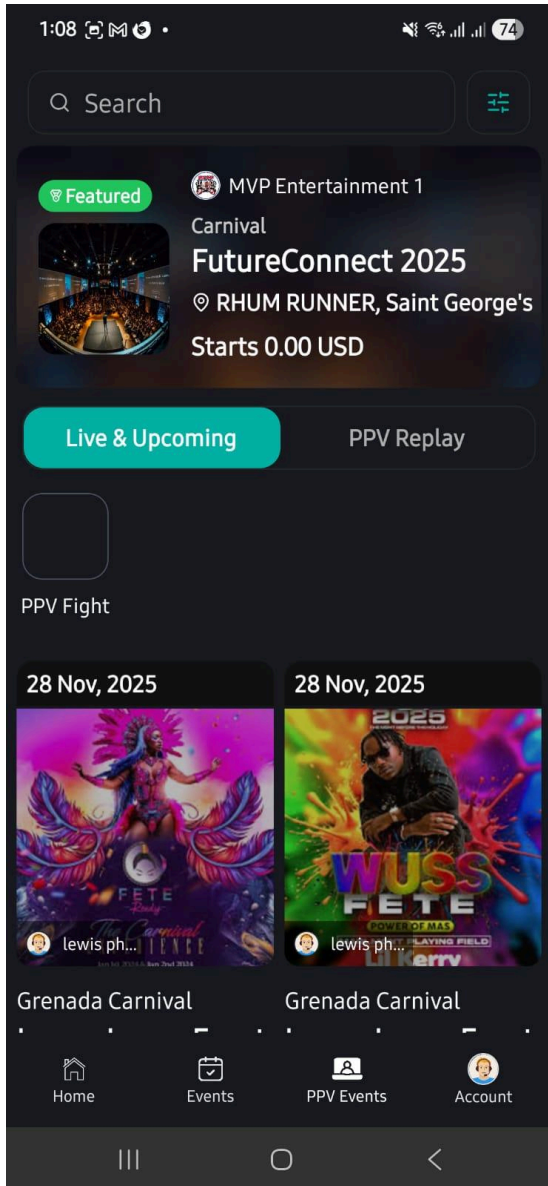


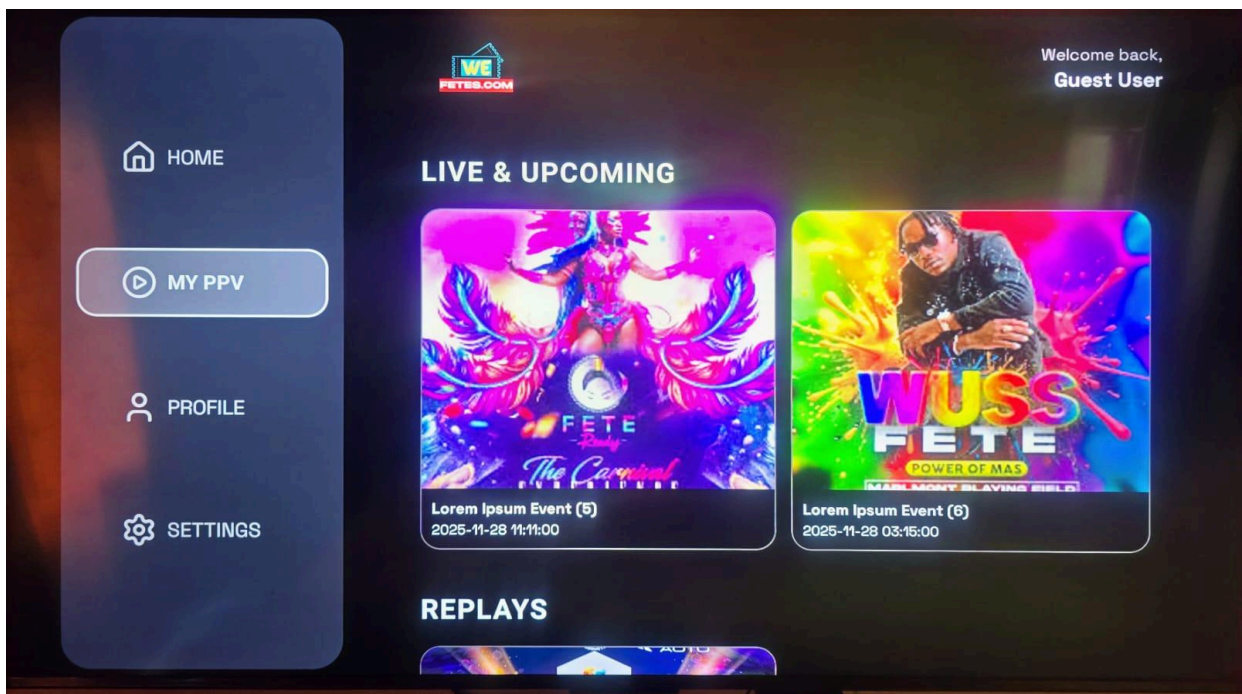
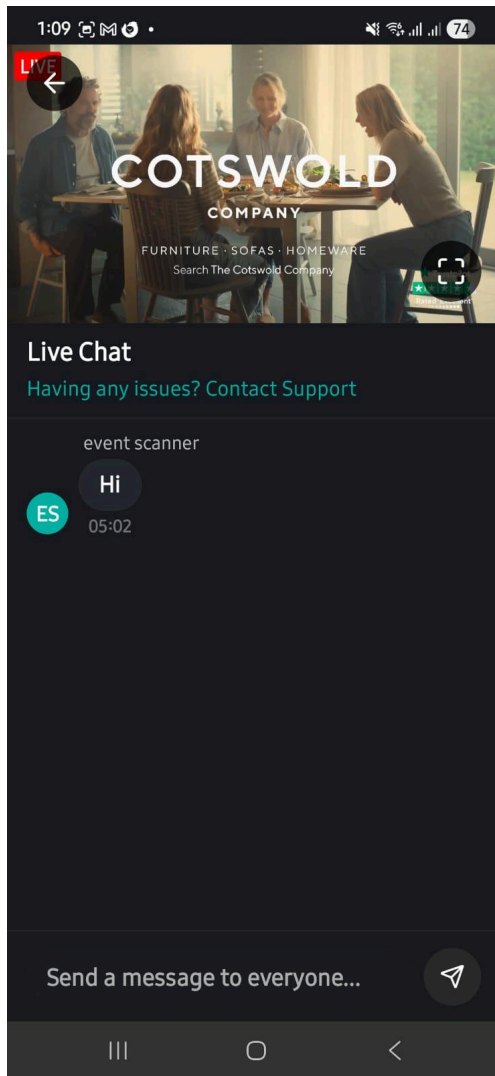
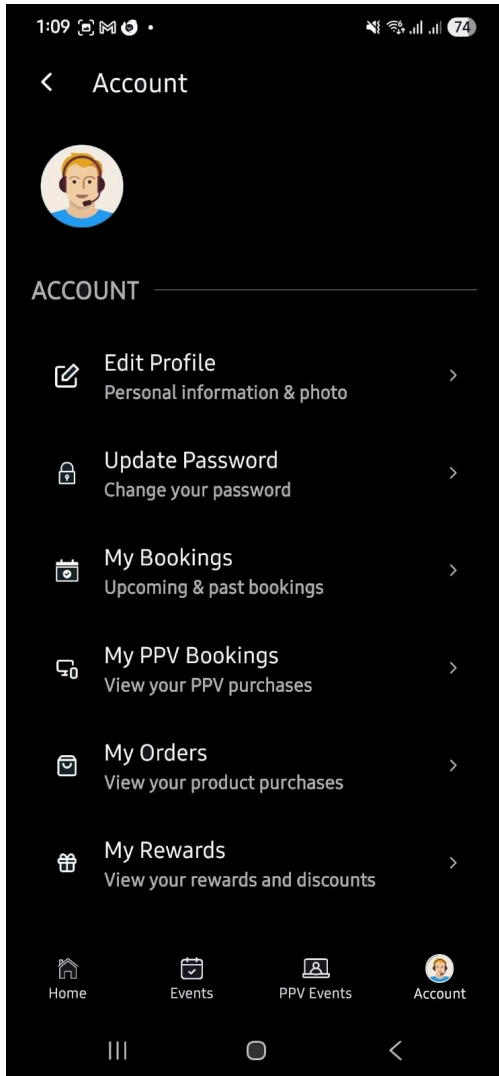
